

Cuba NY Full Throttle Destruction 2017 Stock V-8, Stock Compact, Youth Compact, Team Compact, Truck, Van, & SUV

Rules For Drivers

1. The driver of the vehicle must be 18 years or older and hold a valid driver's license. However, 16 and 17 old drivers may participate with a minor release signed by a parent or legal guardian. The minors release MUST be signed and witnessed by a demolition derby official at the time of registration.
 2. All drivers must wear long pants (NO SHORTS). Full body protection is required.
 3. All drivers MUST wear a seat belt, helmet and eye protection, all of which must be worn at all times while on the track. Neck braces and roll over bars are suggested but not required.
 4. NO smoking is allowed on the track or in any vehicle on the track at any time
 5. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are allowed on the premises at any time. Anyone found in violation will be removed.
 6. Children under the age of 14 will NOT be allowed in the pit area, unless they are driving in the youth demo in which the parent or legal guardian must accompany them. Any other children will be asked to leave. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
 7. Only demo vehicles will be allowed in the pit area. You may bring tools in but then you are required to take your vehicle out of the pit area. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
 8. All demo vehicles MUST be removed within 2 days after the demo, to be specific by sunset on the 2nd day. Vehicles left on the property will then become property of the Cuba Fire Department.
 9. Stealing vehicles or parts from vehicles will be reported to the police.
- Any driver not obeying these rules will be disqualified. The decision of the track officials will be FINAL!!! Entry fee for these classes are \$40 for driver which includes your pit pass. \$20 pit pass.

Rules For Stock V-8, Compact, & Team Compact Class

1. Any 2 door or 4 door automobile or station wagon will be allowed. NO limos, ambulances, hearses, Chrysler imperials, or Chrysler imperial sub frames, School buses, or any other commercial vehicle will be allowed.
2. Windshield and all glass must be removed. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
3. Sun visors, windshield wipers, all lights, mirrors, all chrome/moldings, door handles, antennas, and broken glass MUST be removed.
4. Two 5/16"x1" flat stock or the 5/16" diameter rods must be secured at the top and bottom of the windshield area to prevent the hood from injuring the driver. (Bars can be welded at the top and bottom).
5. Vehicles MUST have a full bench seat or two bucket seats in the front of the car. (If a four point cage is present only one bucket seat is required).
6. NO more than 5 gallons of gas allowed.
7. Interior tank MUST be secured with a minimum of two straps and must be covered with a fire proof shield. If the exterior tank cannot be removed it MUST be punctured to remove fuel (NO dumping fuel on the ground). ANY FUEL LEAK WILL CALL FOR IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.
8. Batteries may be left in the vehicle in front of the firewall in the original location. Battery may be removed and placed in the passenger area and must be securely fastened to the floor with at least 2 straps and Must be covered with a non-metallic cover.
9. All doors, hood, and trunk must be securely fastened with chains, seat belts, or no more than 4 fasteners on each cut off flush.
10. Two 4" welds or two 4"x4" steel plates will be allowed per door.
11. Four 4" welds or four 4"x4" steel plates will be allowed on the trunk.
12. Two 8" diameter (minimum) holes one on each side of the hood over the engine compartment are required NO protruding metal.
13. One 4" inspection hole in the trunk lid required NO protruding metal.
14. Cooling system may be left in or taken out. No anti-freeze/coolant allowed. Cooling system must be flushed (no dumping on the ground) ONLY CLEAR WATER NO EXCEPTION. Fan blade MUST

be removed if not protected by a fan shroud.

15. All vehicles must have functional brakes.

16. You may hard nose and do bumper swaps. No added steel. Vehicle suspension may be stiff. NO special bumpers, reinforcement, or trailer hitches allowed. May swap out bumpers for a bumper off a production car.

17. No agriculture tires or cleated tread allowed any dot vehicle tires (INSPECTORS Discretion). Wheel weights must be removed. Only alterations to rims will be for valve stem protection (INSPECTORS DISCRETION).

18. NO foam filled, or water filled tires will be allowed. Double tires allowed.

19. ONLY the driver's door is to be painted YELLOW and with NO writing.

20. Numbers will be assigned at registration and must be painted on both doors and roof of the vehicle (please make it legible).

21. NO obscene writing allowed on the vehicle.

22. Body mounts can be removed but factory size hardware must be used to remount the body to the frame, in the factory locations NO additional bolts to be used.

23. Any holes in the fire wall MUST be covered with rubber/sheet metal.

24. Hands must remain inside the vehicle at all times while the vehicle is on the track.

Rules For Trucks, Vans, And SUV'S

Same Rules Apply As Economy Plus The Following

1. Two-wheel drive or four wheel drive vehicles (if running a four wheel drive either the front or rear driveshaft MUST be removed).

2. Back window MUST be wire mesh.

3. No hitches or other reinforcements.

4. Fuel tanks MUST be boat type behind the cab inside the frame rails and they MUST be fully covered.

5. Tailgates MUST be bolted, chained, wired, welded or removed. If welded only four 4" welds or four 4"x4" steel plates will be allowed.

6. NO ¾ ton vehicles/axles allowed.

Rules For Youth Demo

Same Rules As Economy Class Plus The Following

1. Any front wheel drives 4 or 6 cylinder (there will be two separate heats).

2. These heats are for 12-15 year olds.

3. NO V8's.

4. NO tucking of the trunk or pre-bending of the frame will be allowed.

5. Drivers need a parent or legal guardian with them at registration to sign a minors release form. The parent or legal guardian may ride in the vehicle with the youth driver (it is strongly recommended that the passenger have a handle inside the passenger compartment).

6. NO bumper swaps MUST remain factory if car has an all plastic bumper you may swap it out for another oem compact bumper within the same age. Also must have bench seat or 2 buckets

The track will be shortened for the youth class this is for their safety. The child must be able to operate the vehicle safely or will not be allowed to drive in the heat (see over steering wheel, operate gas and brake pedal). Seat belt MUST be adjusted properly for the child. They MUST understand these rules before they hit the track.
