Trash Collection

There is no change in trash collection. Put everything out the night before. Refer to the colored zone map for your collection day

Bulk Collection

One bulk item can be placed curbside once per week, collected on the 2nd pick up day

Yard Waste Collection

Garden waste, leaves, small twigs (about 3 ft or less) in an open container.



November-March will be picked up one time a month on the 3rd Wednesday.

April-October will be picked up twice a month on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday.

Single Stream Recycling

Ridley Park Borough has adopted a new recycling program called Single Stream recycling. The borough's recycling collection will now occur **EVERY WEEK** on Wednesday.

THESE ITEMS GET RECYCLED TOGETHER

You can now place all your recyclable in the same container or bag. There is no need to separate any longer.

Glass

Food & beverage containers such as jars and bottles only. Clear, green or brown glass. Remove lids and rinse.



Plastics

#1-#7 food & beverage and detergent containers only. The number is located on the bottom of the bottle or container.



Paper & Cardboard

Newspapers, magazines, office paper and phone books less than an inch. Also shredded paper is accepted



Aluminum & Tin Cans

Aluminum beverage cans and steel and tin food cans. Please rinse the can and remove the lid or push it into the can.



Holiday Collection

If your collection date falls on a holiday your trash will be picked up the next business day.



Holidays:

New Year's Day (January 1), Memorial Day, Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day (December 25).

Unacceptable Materials

Ceramics, dishes, coffee cups, drinking glasses, glass oven ware, vision Ware, window glass, mirrors, light bulbs, styrofoam, packaging, bubble wrap, tissue or paper towels, milk or juice wax cartons,
